



Equipment Safety Checklist

Here is a quick checklist you can use to check over your equipment before you head out or mount up;

- Is your bridle in good condition, no tears, frays or broken pieces?
- Check bridle adjustment, bit position, rein attachments for strength and stability, nose band adjustment is not too tight, and buckles function well.
- If you have any martingales, breast collars, or other equipment check that at this time for adjustment and quality of equipment so it is strong and not compromised.
- Make sure saddle position has not slid, cinch or girth adjustment strong, buckles are secured, leather is not tearing or frayed.
Check stirrup security with buckles and make sure they are secure.
- Tighten your saddle at this time for your safety.
- Check over any of your horse's equipment at this time to make sure secure and functional.
- Check girth/cinch connection on the right side now. Buckles and leather are in good condition and strong, adjustment in correct position.
- Make sure the stirrups/irons on the right side are safe, secured, and leather looks healthy and strong.
- Double check all added equipment such as breast collar, martingale, etc, from this side as well,
